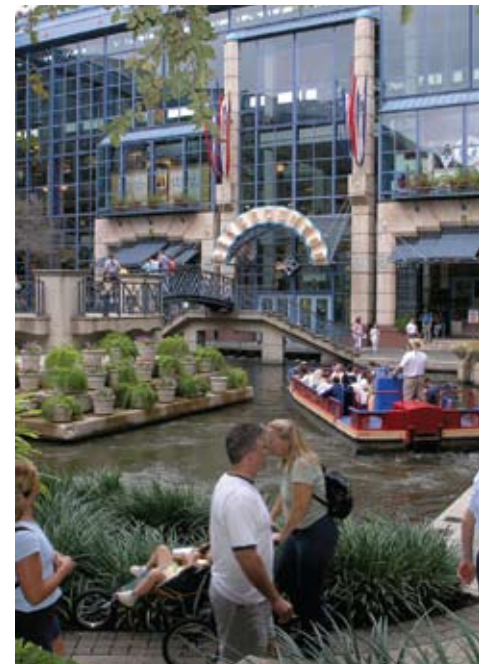
Needs Assessment

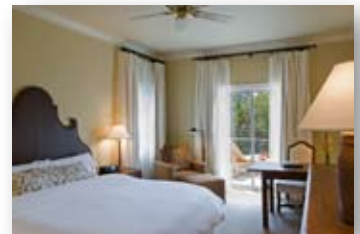

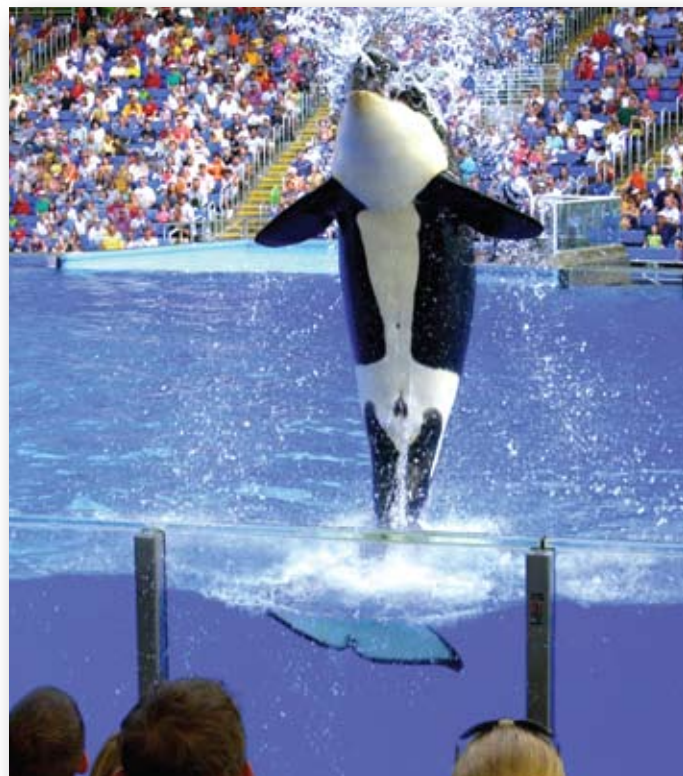
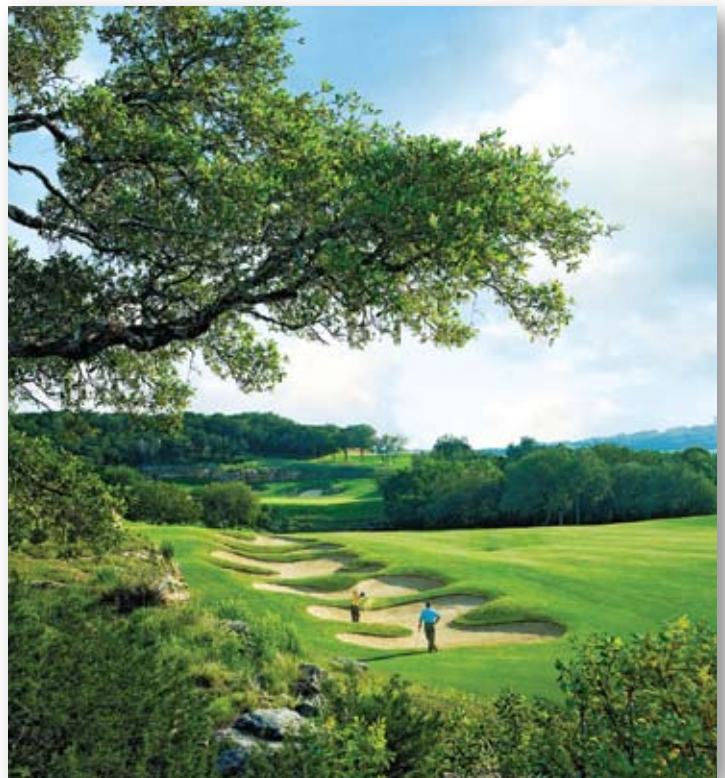
